#### **Explanation of performance dress attire:**

#### DRESS FOR ALL PERFORMANCES IS FULL UNIFORM UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED

FULL UNIFORM: Uniform with overlay, white gloves, beret, black polished shoes, spats, and

pride shirt.

SUMMER UNIFORM: \*flat-front black pants, black polished shoes, spats, red summer uniform shirt

(w/o the spats, the HS summer uniform is Junior High uniform/concert attire)

\*Black twill pants are available at JC Penney, Kohl's, Amazon, Wal-Mart.

Ladies should purchase *Lee*, or *Dickies* Flat-Front twill pants. **Vera Wang Twill Dress pants, SO School Uniform Skinny pants, leggings** 

or yoga pants ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Gentlemen can purchase *Dockers* Classic-fit Flat-Front pants. Black twill, flat-front *Dickies*, available from Wal-Mart, are also acceptable.

JH students can purchase black twill, flat-front Dickies at Wal-Mart

CONCERT UNIFORM: Uniform without overlay, white tuxedo shirt with black buttons,

black bow tie, polished black shoes, spats. (JH see note above).

DRESS CLOTHES: Clothing that is appropriate to wear for a formal event such as a wedding.

Jeans are not appropriate, neither are sweat pants, leggings, yoga pants or

shorts. T-shirts are not acceptable tops.

#### **Concert ARRIVAL and ENTRANCE DOOR policy:**

Band students are asked to arrive prior to concerts in order to dress (high school) and to warm-up and tune their instruments. This process requires a set time in order to get students to the performance stage on time. Unless otherwise indicated, report times will be an hour to forty-five minutes prior to a concert. Concert doors will open one half-hour prior to concert performances with the exception of the Christmas Concert and ARTSFestival which will open one hour before.

#### **Explanation of performance grade policy:**

Band is a performance based class, in other words, performances for a band student are analogous to major projects in other classes, yet unlike projects where a due date can be flexed, performances are singular events determined by time and cannot be re-done.

MISSING A PERFORMANCE FOR ANY REASON, WITH THE EXCLUSION OF PERSONAL ILLNESS, FAMILY EMERGENCY, OR FAMILY VACATION, WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF PERFORMANCE GRADE WITH THE CONSEQUENCE OF A LOWERED QUARTER GRADE.

This calendar is provided to enable students to plan accordingly. Scheduled band events, regardless whether those events are band practices or performances, are never optional for anyone in the group. Participation in non-school, non-OHSAA athletic events does not constitute a reason for missing band performances.

While every attempt has been made to provide a complete calendar for the entire year, additional performances may arise that are not presently scheduled. Should additional opportunities be presented, students will be informed in a timely manner so they will not have to miss participating with their friends.
