Scams

Beware of Scholarship Scams!! The Federal Trade Commission offers the following signs that a scholarship offer is NOT legitimate:

- a. "The scholarship is guaranteed or your money back."
- b. "You can't get this information anywhere else."
- c. "May I have your credit card or bank account number to hold this scholarship?"
- d. "We'll do all the work."
- e. "The scholarship will cost you some money."
- f. "You've been 'selected' by a national foundation to receive a scholarship."
- g. "You are a 'finalist' in a contest you have never entered."

Eligibility: Applicant must be a high school senior, US citizen, does NOT need to be related to a member of the Elks, have either an ACT or SAT score by Nov. 5

Amount: Multiple: 1 - \$25,000, 24 - \$5,625, 575 - \$3,200 Scholarships
Eligibility: Applicant must be a senior National Honor Society member in good standing who is enrolling in college in the fall

Amount: (4) \$500
Eligibility: Graduating senior who school district is a member of NROSCA and plans to major in

teacher education at an accredited post-secondary institution in the State of Ohio; 2.5 GPA or higher

Burger King Scholars

Amount: \$1,000 Scholarship
Eligibility: Applicant must have a 2.5 GPA, work an average of 10 hours per week for 40 weeks per year, does **not** need to work at Burger King, plan to enroll in college in the fall.

United Way of Hancock County Secor Scholarship

Amount: 1-\$2,000 renewed annually for three additional years
Eligibility: 3.5 GPA, planning to attend an accredited institution of higher learning full time. Candidates must exhibit a strong emphasis on service, leadership and character, with these components evaluated through the application, essay, and a required letter of recommendation.

The Greater Toledo Community Foundation: This application foundation works similarly to how our Hancock

County Community Foundation Scholarship Application works. There are several scholarships available through their universal application and several scholarships that require extra work. The amounts can vary from \$500-\$6,000 or more. Some of these scholarships are for general northwest Ohio students where some are more specific to college of choice (BG, UT, etc) and specific majors. Mark and Gretchen Zyndorf Scholarship

Eligibility: U.S. citizen graduating high school seniors from Northwest Ohio who have at least one parent incarcerated and are entering an accredited institution of higher education; 2.0 GPA or higher.

Amount: Two to three \$4,000 scholarships (renewable duration of undergraduate degree)

Engineers Foundation of Ohio (EFO)

Amount: Multiple Scholarships.

Eligibility: Applicant must be a graduating high school senior admitted to an engineering program approved by ABET, minimum 3.0 GPA, ACT Math 29 and English 25 or SAT Math 600 Reading or Comp. 500, citizen of US & permanent resident of Ohio.

- Profiles are free to create and you will earn microscholarships for things like visiting a college, being on a sports team, doing well in your freshman biology class, etc.
