BUSINESS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO THE BOARD

The Board shall appoint a Business Advisory Council whose membership and organization shall be determined by the Board.

For this purpose, the Board may appoint the Hancock County Educational Service Center's business advisory council (HCESCBAC) to represent the business of the Board. If appointed, the Board will appoint one District resident business person to the HCESCBAC to represent the Arlington Local School District.

The HCESCBAC adopts and files with the Ohio Department of Education, an annual plan under which the council advises and provides recommendations to the Board on matters specified by the Board including, but not necessarily limited to, the delineation of employment skills, the development of curriculum to instill these skills; changes in the economy and in the job market and the types of employment in which future jobs are most likely to be available. This council shall also make suggestions for developing a working relationship among businesses, labor organizations and educational personnel.

The HCESCBAC meets at least quarterly. The Board and council file a joint statement by March 1 each year describing how they have fulfilled their responsibilities.

Meetings of the Hancock County Business Advisory Council fall under the auspices of the Open Meetings Act (Sunshine Law).
