

EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

The Superintendent/designee may close the school, dismiss students early or delay the opening of school in the event of hazardous weather, other emergencies which threaten the safety or health of students or staff members, law enforcement emergencies or other circumstances where the Superintendent determines a closure, dismissal or delay is necessary. It is understood that the Superintendent/designee takes such action only after consultation with transportation and other necessary authorities.

Parents, students and staff members are informed early in each school year of the method of notification in the event of emergency closings or early dismissals.

The District will make up the time missed if the schools are closed due to a bomb threat (or any other act of inducing panic) in one-half hour increments added to other school days.
