TUTORING FOR PAY

No teacher will tutor for pay a student who is a member of his class without superintendent approval. Tutorial assistance to students will be considered a normal responsibility of the teacher, except in extenuating circumstances.

A teacher may tutor other students on school premises for pay only in accordance with the following conditions:

- 1. Such tutoring will be done after the regular school day unless special exceptions are approved by the superintendent.
- 2. Tutoring in the school must have the approval of the principal and must be in accordance with district requirements and guidelines for community use of school facilities.
- 3. When tutoring on school premises is approved, it will be performed for no more than the hourly rate of pay received by home instructors employed by the board of education
