CLASSIFIED STAFF SUPPLEMENTARY PAY PLANS

The Board of Education recognizes that it may occasionally be necessary for classified staff persons to work more than forty (40) hours during a given work week. Whenever such overtime situations occur, the following provisions will be applicable to classified staff persons employed in other than supervisory positions:

- 1. For purposes of this policy hours worked means all hours during which the individual is required to be on duty generally from the required starting time to normal quitting time.
 - a. Meal periods don not count as hours worked unless the individual is required to perform work duties during the meal period.
 - b. Break periods of twenty (20) minutes or less do count as work time.
- 2. Individuals who begin work earlier or work later than their assigned hours must receive prior authorization from their immediate supervisor.
- 3. All hours over 40 will be counted time and a half.
- 4. Supervisor will periodically check validity of hours worked.
