INSTRUCTIONAL OBJECTIVES

Instructors shall identify skills, knowledge, and attitudes crucial to the student's successful movement to the next level of learning within each subject area and at each grade level.

The educational program of the District will be the result of systematic planning, articulation, implementation, and evaluation.

Instructors will employ those methodologies as needed to assure accomplishment of that learning necessary to successful movement to the next level of learning.

Courses of study are evaluated on a rotating basis every five years under the supervision of the educational service center. This evaluation considers the achievement of learning objectives and learning outcomes. This evaluation promotes and guides appropriate revision and updating. The evaluated course of study is presented to the County Board for adoption or readoption.
