

INOCULATIONS OF STUDENTS

Immunization against diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, poliomyelitis, reboola, rubella and mumps is required for each student unless the parent(s) file an objection. The Board also requires tuberculosis examinations in compliance with law.

Students eligible for kindergarten and students new to the District must present written evidence of similar immunizations, or written evidence to indicate that they are in the process of receiving immunizations, to be completed no later than the day of entrance. Students entering the seventh grade must present evidence of an MMR booster. Students failing to complete immunizations within 14 days after entering are not permitted to return to school.

All kindergarten students are required to receive hepatitis B and vermicelli (chicken pox) immunizations.
