Interactive and educational space kits have also been prepared by the Hancock County Education Service Center for individual classrooms to explore and learn, including a variety of engagement activities.




### School Wide WIG

For the first time, Arlington Elementary is working towards a School Wide WIG, or "Wildly Important Goal." This WIG is an initiative for our students to keep the cafeteria clean. The WIG began February 20th and will end on March 28th. The goal for both lunch periods (K-2 and 3-6) is to keep the cafeteria clean 22 out of 28 days.
