## Senate Bill 288 (Erin's Law)

- This week, you should have received a handout regarding required Sexual Abuse Training for Ohio Schools. Please make certain to return the OPT OUT forms if you would like your child to be excluded from the instructional videos. Students opting out will simply remain in their classrooms for a classroom activity, while those permitted to view the training will be escorted to the auditorium in grade level groups. Again, Ohio Lawmakers have approved into law that public schools offer this training annually.
- The training video lessons will take place on November 9. Arlington Elementary will work in conjunction with Family Resource Center (FRC), who will provide the developmentally appropriate content for our K-6 students. The content of the lessons will come from Fight Child Abuse, whose "main goal is to educate children about what to do if they experience abusive behavior, educate them about safe & unsafe touches, and encourage them to go to a parent or another trusted adult for help." A short Q&A session with a representative from the FRC will follow.

**IMPORTANT NOTE**: As a courtesy to families who have multiple students, the window for you to sign up on-line begins Wednesday, October 4<sup>th</sup>. On Monday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, all others are welcome to sign up for a time slot. Also, 4th, 5th & 6th grade are asked to ONLY sign up for a conference with their student's homeroom teacher.

- 2) Click on the magnifying glass in the top right corner to "Find a sign up"
- 3) "Search by email" enter creator's email: northrupb@arlingtonlocal.org
- 4) Click security box (you are not a robot.... unless you are)
- 5) Click on orange "Search" button
- 6) Click on "Parent/Teacher Conferences" the link is orange in color
- 7) It is going to ask you for an Access Code: enter AHS23
- 8) By scrolling down, select the date/time/teacher and click the maroon "**Sign up**" box that corresponds; then complete the requested information.
- 9) Click the maroon "Save & Continue" button at the bottom that pops up.
- 10) Enter your student's first and last name in the **"My Comment"** section. Then, you will enter your first and last name, your email address, and phone number.
- 11) Complete your sign up by clicking the maroon **Sign up Now** button

  You have the option of getting a reminder one day in advance of your appointment(s) and the option to sign up for an account if you want the ability to change your appointment(s)... and you're done!
