The 7th graders gave back to the community on May 12th by visiting four different nonprofit organizations. One group went to City Mission where they put together personal hygiene kits that they can give out to those in need. Another 10 students went to the Restore shop that is with the Habitat for Humanity organization. At the store that takes second hand household goods, the students cleaned and organized items that had been dropped off for donation. A third group stayed in Arlington to help out with some outside cleanup at the Good Samaritan Nursing home. The final group went to Mission Possible in Findlay. This organization has a partnership with schools in Haiti & Dominican Republic, they work with the schools for ways to improve their education system.
