End-of-Day Dismissal Memo:

We recognize the high congestion of vehicles and movement in our front parking lot during the after-school dismissal time. Our objective remains to maintain safety.

A couple of points of emphasis to consider:

- 1. With over 100 children exiting the front of the building, please be prepared to exercise your patience. If you arrive at 2:59, it may take you 5-7 minutes to retrieve and exit the premises with your child. Consider arriving closer to 3:03 or 3:04. In this case, you may more easily find a parking spot and still be able to exit the premises by 3:07. This would allow for a shortened span of your time for pick-up.
- 2. Please avoid parking and exiting vehicles along the grassy lawn and even the curbside sidewalk, as this slows the flow and blocks the view of pedestrian movement on the sidewalks. I do recognize that at 3:01, there may be no other spots available for parking, thus forcing folks to utilize the curbside. Coming a few minutes after 3:00 will eliminate the need to use the curb for parking.
- 3. When crossing from the sidewalk to the parking lot, please use the designated and marked spots.
- 4. Please respect that the handicap spaces on the south end of the school are truly designated for those with handicap needs. Please do not utilize these spaces unless you are permitted to do so.

KINDERGARTEN SCREENING for 2024-2025 School Year:

- The Arlington Local School District Kindergarten screening date is set for **Thursday, March 7th, 2024.**
- Students are eligible for kindergarten if they will be five before August 1, 2024.
- Parents of incoming students should contact the elementary school office between January 29th and February 23 to register for a time slot for the screening date. (419) 365-5121, ex. 244.
- Parents and students will report to the Arlington Elementary library at their scheduled time.
- All children attending the screening and enrolling must reside in the Arlington School District; parents of students who wish to open enroll should have children screened in their home district.
- Parents should bring the following documentation to complete the enrollment to the **March 7th screening.** Nothing needs to be collected in the office prior to March 7th; simply make a phone call to the office between January 29-February 23 to sign up for a time slot.
 - Social security card
 - Birth certificate
 - Proof of residency (utility bill with address in parent's name)
 - Vaccination records
 - Court/custody documentation, if necessary

(Copies of the above documents will be made during the screening time session, and the originals will be given back to parents by the end of the screening.)
