- ➤ <u>NEW! HOMEWORK-FREE HOLIDAY:</u> So our students and staff can enjoy Winter Break free from school expectations, there will be NO homework assignments, projects, etc. for students to work on from December 22, 2021 thru January 2, 2022! - ➤ NEW! FIRST FRIDAY ASSEMBLIES: In November we started having monthly assemblies that will address issues currently affecting our 7th thru 12th grade students. - > STOPit: This year, Arlington is once again utilizing the STOPit reporting system, which allows students, parents, or teachers to ANONYMOUSLY report harassment, bullying, weapons, vapes, drugs, threats, and concerns about depression or self-harm in others. Go to appweb.stopitsolutions.com to submit a report, enter the school access code ARLINGTON, and then complete the required information. Reports are delivered directly to school administrators for their review.
- ➤ <u>SCHOOL NOTIFICATIONS:</u> Ohio Alerts, a notification system previously used by Arlington and many other schools and agencies, is no longer in use. Parents are encouraged to sign up for text alerts through the WFIN/WKXA website <u>delays.wfin.com</u>, or through the Remind text messaging service (see below, grades 7-12 only), for important information, delays, cancellations, and other announcements.
