- ➤ First Semester grade cards were available to view in ProgressBook as of last Friday, January 22. Due to the challenges with communicating effectively during our hybrid learning model and to make sure all parents are aware of student grades, we WILL be mailing First Semester grade cards home by Friday, January 29. Please watch the mail for those grade cards next week!
- The Ohio Department of Education provides a free opportunity for all juniors in the state to take the ACT test. All JUNIORS at Arlington High School will take the ACT this year on Tuesday, February 23. Additionally, all SOPHOMORES will take the Pre-ACT on the same day. All other students (Grades 7, 8, 9, and 12) will have REMOTE learning activities that day and will NOT be attending school in-person on Tuesday, February 23. Please watch for additional details regarding expectations for this day.
- ➤ We are currently waiting on information from the Ohio Department of Education regarding state testing requirements for this school year. At this time, we expect that these tests will be administered this spring. While testing dates have not yet been finalized, we anticipate the window to administer these tests will be from the end of March through the beginning of May. Again, please watch for additional information.
- ➤ We will soon begin the scheduling process for the 2021-2022 school year. A Scheduling Team of teachers, Mrs. Hutcheson, and Mr. Sorg is meeting to create the course schedule for next year. Part of that process will be to provide course request forms to the students to determine the courses they would like to take next year. Stay tuned for more information about this process in the coming weeks!
- ➤ Looking ahead on the calendar, there will be NO SCHOOL on Monday, February 15, due to the Presidents' Day holiday. Also, the end of the 3rd Quarter is Friday, March 19.
- ➤ Please remind your students that appropriate wearing of masks is important to limit everyone's exposure. We have seen some students wearing their masks without their mouth or nose completely covered during the school day. We realize beliefs vary on the wearing of masks, but all students and staff are required to wear them while attending school or school events (with certain exceptions).
