- **UPDATE! ONLINE STATE TESTS:** The annual online state tests for students in Grades 7-12 will begin soon! This year we will once again use a 2-hour delay schedule for JH/HS ONLY to administer some of our tests. Buses and elementary classes will follow their regular schedules. The schedule for testing is:
 - **Monday, April 4 & Tuesday, April 5 – English Language Arts – 2-Hour Delay schedule**
 - Students in grades 7, 8, and 10 are required to report to school by 8:00 AM for testing. Part 1 of the test will be on Monday, Part 2 on Tuesday, from 8:00 - 10:00 AM both days. Students in grades 9, 11, and 12 do not need to report to school until 10:00 AM, when all junior high/high school students will follow the 2-hour delay bell schedule. Non-testing students who arrive to school before 10:00 AM will report to the cafeteria.
 - **Monday, April 18 – American History & American Government – Regular schedule**
 - Students in grade 9 (American History) and most of grade 11 (American Government) will take Parts 1 and 2 of those respective tests during Periods 1-4. When finished with their tests, they will join all other students in their regular classes. THERE IS NO DELAY SCHEDULE ON THIS DAY.
 - **Tuesday, April 19 – Science 8 & Biology – Regular schedule**
 - Students in grade 8 (Science 8) and grade 9 (Biology) will take Parts 1 and 2 of those respective tests during Periods 1-4. When finished with their tests, they will join all other students in their regular classes. THERE IS NO DELAY SCHEDULE ON THIS DAY.
 - **Monday, April 25 & Tuesday, April 26 – Mathematics – 2-Hour Delay schedule**
 - Students enrolled in Math 7, Math 8, Algebra, or Geometry are required to report to school by 8:00 AM for testing. Part 1 of the test will be on Monday, Part 2 on Tuesday, from 8:00 - 10:00 AM both days. Students who are not in any of these math classes do not need to report to school until 10:00 AM, when all junior high/high school students will follow the 2-hour delay bell schedule. Non-testing students who arrive to school before 10:00 AM will report to the cafeteria.
