- **REMINDER** STATE TESTING/2-HOUR DELAY ON MONDAY, APRIL 19, & TUESDAY, APRIL 20: This year's state testing begins on Monday, April 19. Please read below for IMPORTANT reminders for next week:
 - Students in Grades 7, 8, and 10 will take the ELA tests on Monday, April 19 (Part I) and Tuesday, April 20 (Part II).
 - These students must report to school at the regular time of 8:00AM. They will be assigned to classrooms for testing purposes. Those room assignments will be emailed to students and parents on Friday, April 16.
 - The tests will take place from 8:00AM 10:00AM. At 10:00AM, ALL students will begin classes for the day following a 2-Hour Delay bell schedule.
 - Transportation will be provided at the regular times, as the elementary school will follow a regular schedule. Students not taking a test either day will be allowed to report to school at 10:00AM for the start of classes. Any students needing to ride the bus or get dropped off to school at 8:00AM will report to the cafeteria for a free breakfast or to work on assignments.
 - o A regular on-time bell schedule will be followed the rest of the week.
- **REMINDER** STATE TESTING/2-HOUR DELAY ON MONDAY, APRIL 26, & TUESDAY, APRIL 27: Additional state testing will take place on Monday, April 26, and Tuesday, April 27. Testing on these days will be for students in Math 7, Math 8, Algebra, and Geometry. These tests will follow the 2-Hour Delay schedule described above for students in these math classes. Any students not enrolled in these math classes will be allowed to report to school at 10:00AM for the start of classes.
- **REMINDER** STATE TESTING/REGULAR BELL SCHEDULE ON MONDAY, MAY 3, & TUESDAY, MAY 4: Additional state testing will take place on Monday, May 3, and Tuesday, May 4. However, these tests will be taken during the regular school day and WILL NOT be on a 2-Hour Delay schedule. ALL students should report to school at 8:00AM on those days, and those taking state tests will report to the testing areas from their regular classrooms. Students in 8th grade Science and Biology will take Part I and Part II of those tests on Monday, May 3. Students in American History and Government will take Part I and Part II of those tests on Tuesday, May 4.
- **CANCELLED** EARLY DISMISSAL FOR GRADES 7-12 ON APRIL 22: Due to some unforeseen circumstances with the planned professional development for JH/HS teachers, the early release for students in Grades 7-12 on Thursday, April 22, HAS BEEN CANCELLED. Students will follow a regular bell schedule that day and will be dismissed from school at the regular time of 3:05PM.
- ➤ PROM: An in-person Junior/Senior Prom will be held on Saturday, April 24, from 8:00-11:00PM. Tickets are currently on sale for juniors and seniors who would like to attend. Students should see Mr. Valasek, Mrs. Cheney, or any member of the planning committee for details. Students bringing a guest from outside Arlington High School MUST submit a completed Dance Guest Form by Wednesday, April 21. All guests MUST have a photo ID to be admitted to the dance.

- ➤ LAST DAY OF SCHOOL/EARLY DISMISSAL: The last day of school for the 2020-2021 school year is Thursday, May 27. There will also be a district-wide early dismissal at 1:00PM that day.
