- ➤ <u>SCHOOL VACCINATIONS</u>: State law requires all students entering 7th grade to have a booster dose of Tdap one-dose meningococcal vaccine, and all students entering 12th grade to have two booster doses of meningococcal vaccine. Students must do one of the following by Monday, September 26, 2022:
  - Provide immunization records verifying the appropriate vaccines have been received; or
  - o File the appropriate exemption paperwork with the school office or school nurse; or
  - o Provide verification of a scheduled appointment to receive the appropriate vaccines.

Students who are unable to provide one of the above forms by Monday, September 26 will not permitted to attend school starting Tuesday, September 27, until this documentation is received.

Reports are delivered directly to school administrators for their review.

- SAFER OHIO SCHOOL TIP LINE: Another reporting system is the Safer Ohio School Tip Line. Individuals can anonymously report concerns by calling or texting 844-SaferOH (844-723-3764). Once a report is received and determined by Ohio Homeland Security officials to need further action, the information will be forwarded to local law enforcement and school officials.
