

## Sorg's Scoop Updates

- **REMINDER – CHRISTMAS COMMUNITY CAFE:** The Junior Lighthouse Team is excited to announce the Christmas Community Cafe! We will be hosting a drive-thru from 8:00-9:00 AM at the cafeteria doors TOMORROW Friday, December 16 for the community! All drinks are handcrafted and there will also be homemade baked goods for sale, thanks to community members Mrs. Cavinee, Mrs. Griggs, and Mrs. Inbody. Payment is cash only! All funds raised will go toward our Leader in Me program.
- **REMINDER – SEMESTER EXAM SCHEDULE, PART I:** Semester exams will take place for high school students in grades 9-12 on Monday, December 19; Tuesday, December 20; and Wednesday, December 21. Students in 8th grade taking courses for high school credit will also participate in the exams for those courses. In the event of a school cancellation on any of those days, make-up exams will take place on Thursday, December 22 (exams will take place on the scheduled day if there is a delay). The full schedule will be included as an email attachment to students and parents, and is also available in the Information Center outside the HS Office.
- **REMINDER – SEMESTER EXAM SCHEDULE, PART II:** Students in Grades 9-12, with parent permission, can be excused from attending an exam period for which there is no actual class scheduled (such as a study hall, teacher aide, or office helper period). They can also participate in an Open Lunch on the exam days from 12:10-1:35 PM. Students entering/exiting the building at times other than the usual 8:00 AM start time and 3:05 dismissal time must enter through the cafeteria doors, and are responsible for their own transportation to/from school. The normal bus transportation schedule will be in effect on the exam days. The Parent Permission & Student Pledge form will be included as an email attachment to students and parents, and is also available in the Information Center outside the HS Office (attached to the exam schedule).
- **REMINDER! CHRISTMAS BREAK/EARLY RELEASE:** There will be a 2-Hour Early Release from school at 1:05 PM on Thursday, December 22 (1:00 for elementary students). Students and teachers will then be on Christmas Break from Friday, December 23, 2022 thru Monday, January 2, 2023. School will resume on Tuesday, January 3, 2023.
- **MILLSTREAM APPLICATION FOR SOPHOMORES:** Sophomores interested in attending Millstream for the 2023-2024 school year should apply as soon as possible. The online application can be found at <http://bit.ly/millstreamapp>. The deadline for priority applications is Sunday, January 15, 2023. Contact Mrs. Thompson or Mr. Sorg with any questions.
- **END OF SEMESTER/SCHEDULING FOR 2023-2024:** The final day of the 2nd Quarter/1st Semester is Friday, January 13, 2023. That means the scheduling process for the 2023-2024 school year is not far behind! Please watch for updates and information related to course scheduling at the start of the new year in January!
- **STOPit:** This year, Arlington is once again utilizing the STOPit reporting system, which allows students, parents, or teachers to ANONYMOUSLY report harassment, bullying, weapons, vapes, drugs, threats, and concerns about depression or self-harm in others. Go to [appweb.stopitsolutions.com](http://appweb.stopitsolutions.com) to submit a report, enter the school access code ARLINGTON, and then complete the required information. Reports are delivered directly to school administrators for their review.

- **SAFER OHIO SCHOOL TIP LINE:** Another reporting system is the Safer Ohio School Tip Line. Individuals can anonymously report concerns by calling or texting 844-SaferOH (844-723-3764). Once a report is received and determined by Ohio Homeland Security officials to need further action, the information will be forwarded to local law enforcement and school officials.
