- SCHEDULING FOR 2023-2024: The scheduling process for the 2023-2024 school year has begun! Mrs. Thompson and I are conducting grade-level meetings with all students in grades 6-11, during which students will be given a Course Request form with an explanation of the scheduling process. Students and parents are encouraged to contact Mrs. Thompson with any scheduling questions or concerns. The signed Course Request forms are due back in the office by Friday, February 3, to give us sufficient time to develop the master schedule for next school year.
- GRADUATION PLANS: Students in grades 9-11 have recently been given their individual Graduation Plan summaries. Parents should review the information that has already been provided in the plan and then sign the plan. Students should then return the plan to the office with their Course Request form they will receive in the scheduling meetings.
- STOPit: Arlington is utilizing the STOPit reporting system, which allows students, parents, or teachers to ANONYMOUSLY report harassment, bullying, weapons, vapes, drugs, threats, and concerns about depression or self-harm in others. Go to <u>appweb.stopitsolutions.com</u> to submit a report, enter the school access code ARLINGTON, and then complete the required information. Reports are delivered directly to school administrators for their review.
- SAFER OHIO SCHOOL TIP LINE: Another reporting system is the Safer Ohio School Tip Line. Individuals can anonymously report concerns by calling or texting 844-SaferOH (844-723-3764). Once a report is received and determined by Ohio Homeland Security officials to need further action, the information will be forwarded to local law enforcement and school officials.
