American Rescue Plan: Safe Return to In-person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan

Each district and community school should post on its local website a plan which includes, or will be modified to include, the extent to which it has adopted policies and a description of any such policies on each of the following mitigation strategies:

- Universal and correct wearing of masks:
Masks are strongly recommended and encouraged for students and staff while inside our K-12 building.
Masks are required on school transportation including athletic and extracurricular trips.
- Physical Distancing:
When possible, students and staff will remain at least 3 feet apart indoors and 6 feet when possible.
Students will not be socially distanced on the school bus.
- Handwashing and respiratory etiquette:
Arlington Local School will continue with current handwashing and respiratory etiquette guidelines.
- Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation:
Arlington Local School will continue with the current cleaning and disinfecting guidelines.
Students should bring their own water bottles to school and use the bottle fill stations located throughout the building.
- Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the state, local, territorial or tribal health departments:
Arlington Local School will follow the Ohio Department of Health and Hancock County Board of Health guidelines.
Positive individuals should stay home. Positive individuals will be sent home from school.
Positive test results should be reported to Hancock Public Health (419-424-7105).
- Diagnostic and screening testing:
Arlington Local School will follow the Ohio Department of Health and Hancock County Board of Health guidelines.
- Efforts to provide vaccinations to educators, other staff and students, if eligible:
Arlington Local School will follow the locally approved Board policy regarding vaccinations. They will work with the Hancock County Health Department to provide information on opportunities for vaccinations.
- Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to the health and safety policies:
- **Arlington Local School will follow the locally approved Board policy regarding students with disabilities.**

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Each district and community school should post on its local website a plan which describes how it will ensure continuity of services including but not limited to:

- Services to address the students' academic needs, and students' and staff social, emotional, mental health and other needs, which may include student health and food services:
Arlington Local School's Administrative and Teacher Teams will review student data and identify both academic needs and SEL needs. These teams will provide input into how to best support the identified needs throughout the instructional day or by offering services outside of the regular school day. They will also collect data on staff's social, emotional, mental health and other needs for determining how to best support the identified needs of staff.
- The LEA periodically reviews, no less frequently than every six months for the duration of the ARP ESSER grant period (i.e., through September 30, 2023), and revises its plan as appropriate:
The Administrative Team and Teacher Teams will meet no less than twice a year to review students' academic needs, and students' and staff social, emotional, mental health and other needs and will revise our plan as needed to meet identified needs.
- The LEA seeks public input and takes such input into account on (1) whether revisions are necessary and, if so, (2) the revisions to the plan:
The Administrative Team and Teacher Teams will seek public input on whether or not revisions are needed and will make plan revisions as needed to meet identified needs.
